

### Section 2 – Adult social work

Note: In view of the continuing development of the indicators for social work services, some of the indicators contained in this section may be considered to contain 'transitional' elements in accordance with the developed criteria (see Section 1). However, none have specifically been identified as 'transitional'.

#### Community care

- 1. The number of people assessed or reviewed and the number receiving a service expressed as a rate per 1,000 relevant population in the seven main groups of adult users of community care services:**
  - elderly people (aged 65+)
  - elderly people (aged 65+) with dementia
  - people (aged 18-64) with mental health problems
  - people (aged 18-64) with physical disabilities
  - people (aged 18-64) with learning disabilities
  - people (aged 18-64) with HIV or AIDS
  - people (aged 18-64) with drug or alcohol abuse problems.

#### *What the indicator reports*

The indicator reports:

- the number of assessments and reviews carried out
- the number of people who received a service.

Assessment and review are the key activities in social work. Their purpose is to identify the need, if any, that a person has for social care. The council is responsible for ensuring that assessments are carried out. Assessments are usually undertaken by social workers or other social work department staff such as occupational therapists, but they may also be carried out, wholly or in part, by the staff of other care agencies.

When a person has been found to have need for a service or services following an assessment or a review, the council attempts to provide the services required.

#### *Points to bear in mind*

The information on the number of assessments or reviews undertaken shows the scale of the task facing each council, and so it is contextual rather than performance-related information. It will be affected by:

- the particular patterns of need for social care in the council's area
- the number of requests for assessment received ('referrals').

The indicator should not be affected by the resources available to meet those needs. Central government guidance requires that all the needs for each person should be considered, even if the council does not have enough resources to provide a service to meet some or all of these needs.

The council may not always be able to provide the service because:

- the user has expressed a preference for a particular service and there is a waiting time for that service
- there is a delay in providing the service because of a lack of resources. This may mean that no service will be available, or that there may be a waiting time.

The provision of a service or services to a person is reported only when it is actually delivered. As a result, there will be some people who were assessed as needing a service who had not yet received it at the end of the reporting period.

### Spending on clients

#### 2. Expenditure on services for adults in community care client groups:

- home and community based services
- long-term residential and nursing home care.

#### *What the indicator reports*

The indicator shows how expenditure on community care client groups is distributed between home and community based services and long-term residential and nursing home services. It is expressed as cost per head of the population aged 18 and over. This information will enable councils to monitor the implementation of community care policy in relation to changes in the balance of care.

Home and community based services include home care, meals on wheels, equipment and adaptations, direct payments, other domiciliary services, day care, lunch clubs, community alarms, supported accommodation, wardens for sheltered housing, respite care in residential and nursing homes, and other respite care.

#### *Points to bear in mind*

The indicator will be affected by:

- the pattern of need within the council area, influenced by the age-structure of the adult population, the distribution of poverty and ill health, household composition, and other factors
- the level of services provided by the NHS and other providers
- the extent to which councils already have high proportions of expenditure on home and community based services, which may limit the potential for further shifts in expenditure.

### Staff qualification

#### 3. The percentage of care staff in residential homes who have appropriate qualifications for:

- elderly people
- other adults.

#### *What the indicator reports*

This indicator reports an aspect of the quality of residential care for each of the user groups. The extent to which care staff have appropriate qualifications is one of a number of factors which contribute to the quality of residential care, but it is significant.

#### *Points to bear in mind*

The indicator will be affected by:

- the policies of councils on recruiting staff who are suitably qualified, and on training existing staff
- the availability of suitably qualified staff.

The indicator relates only to staff in residential homes managed by councils. Voluntary and private sector homes are not included.

### Privacy in residential accommodation

- 4: The number of single rooms and the number of rooms with en-suite facilities, expressed as a percentage of residential care places used by the council for each client group.

#### *What the indicator reports*

Research on the preferences of residents in residential establishments shows that privacy is of particular importance. Therefore, the indicator measures this particular aspect of the quality of the residential care.

The indicator is based on the number of bedrooms intended solely for one person, and excludes rooms which have two or more beds but are used by only one person.

En-suite facilities will have as a minimum a shower or bath in the apartment for the sole use of the resident, but it should be recognised that many homes, but not all, will provide a higher standard than this.

#### *Points to bear in mind*

The indicator is likely to be affected by:

- limitations in the resources available to councils and the owners of homes in the voluntary and private sectors to improve homes by increasing the number of single rooms
- the physical layout of an existing home, which may limit the scope for creating single rooms
- design standards for new homes which encourage greater provision of single rooms

It is desirable for councils to retain some double rooms to accommodate married or cohabiting couples.

### Home care/Home helps

- 5: a) The number of people age 65+ receiving homecare  
 b) The number of homecare hours per 1,000 population age 65+  
 c) As a proportion of home care clients age 65+, the number receiving:
- personal care
  - a service during evenings/overnight
  - a service at weekends

#### *What the indicator reports*

Home care is one of the most important services available to local authorities to support people with community care needs to remain at home. The indicator measures the overall volume of service for the largest client group, in terms of both the total number of clients and the total number of home care hours provided or purchased per 1,000 people age 65+.

Increasing the flexibility of the service is a key policy objective for both central and local government, to ensure that people receive the type of assistance which they need, when they need it. The indicator measures flexibility in terms of the extent to which:

- care is provided outwith normal working hours to meet clients' needs

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- personal care is provided, in addition to help with domestic tasks.

### **Points to bear in mind**

The indicator will be affected by:

- the pattern of need and demand within the council area, influenced by the age-structure of the elderly population, the distribution of poverty and ill health, household composition, and other factors
- the particular needs of people who receive the service
- the balance between home-based and residential care services in the council area.

The indicator only captures 'home care services' which are provided on an hourly basis. Other services which support people at home, such as laundry services, home shopping, community alarms and meals-on-wheels, are not included.

## Respite care

### **6: Provision of respite services:**

### **What the indicator reports**

Respite care is a support for the carer(s) of vulnerable individuals, supplying temporary relief from the responsibility of providing care, by the provision of alternative care. Often the purpose of respite care is to prevent a breakdown in care in the household, which results in the person having to be admitted to permanent care. Respite care may, therefore, be provided on a planned or an emergency basis.

Respite care can take various forms, such as admission to residential care for the vulnerable person, 'sitter' services, 'share-the-care' and 'breaks-and-opportunities' schemes.

The number of bed-nights and hours provided or purchased provides a measure of the total volume of respite care provided or purchased and comparison can be made between the level of provision amongst councils.

### **Points to bear in mind**

The indicator will be affected primarily by:

- the volume of requests for assessment for respite care and the pattern of services required
- the availability of respite care
- the priority given by the council to the development of respite care.

## Social enquiry reports

### **7. The number of social enquiry reports submitted to courts during the year and the number expressed as a rate per 1,000 adult population**

**The proportion of reports requested by courts allocated to social work staff with two working days of receipt by the social work department and the proportion of reports submitted by the due date**

### **What the indicator reports**

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The first part of this indicator provides information about the volume of social enquiry work undertaken, while the second part measures the efficiency of the service provided in terms of the proportion of cases which meet the timescales for the key social work actions set out in the 'National Objectives and Standards for Social Work in the Criminal Justice System'.

### ***Points to bear in mind***

All Social Enquiry Reports submitted to courts during the reporting year, including pre-trial reports are included.

### **Probation**

- 8:      a) **The number of new probation orders issued during the year and the number expressed as rate per 1,000 population**
- b) **The proportion of new probationers seen by a supervising officer within one week, and the proportion of people subject to a probation order who were reported to the court for breach of probation during the year.**

### ***What the indicator reports***

The first part of this indicator provides information about the volume of probation work undertaken, while the second part measures the efficiency of the service. However, the proportion of probationers seen within a week of the order being made will be adversely affected by probationers not attending scheduled appointments and by late notifications of Orders by the courts.

### ***Points to bear in mind***

High breach levels do not necessarily indicate poor performance. It may mean that the service is not able to encourage offenders on supervision to comply with the terms of the probation order or alternatively, that the strictness with which the probation service follows breach protocols.

### **Community service**

- 9:      a) **The number of new community service orders issued during the year**
- b) **The average number of hours per week taken to complete orders.**

### ***What the indicator reports***

The first part of this indicator provides information about the volume of community service work undertaken. The second part measures the efficiency of the service, showing how quickly criminal justice services are helping those convicted to complete their orders.

### ***Points to bear in mind***

Community service tends to be more effective the shorter the time required to complete the hours ordered by the court. However, it is also important that councils match the programme of community service to the needs and abilities of the client. Unless the service programme is of a suitable quality it is unlikely that the order will be successful in reducing re-offending. There will, therefore be occasions when it is inappropriate to work through the order too quickly.

### **Adult social work**

Auditors appointed by the Accounts Commission have reviewed councils' arrangements for producing the performance information. In the table below, an 'x' is shown against an indicator where the auditor expressed doubts about the reliability of the authority's arrangements for producing the information.
