

# Waste management

## Refuse collection

1: The net cost of refuse:

- a) collection (combined domestic commercial and domestic bulky uplift) per premise
- b) disposal per premise.

### *What the indicator reports*

This indicator shows how much it costs each council to collect and dispose of refuse.

The indicator reports the cost of collecting refuse from dwellings and commercial premises (eg shops), including the cost of special collections of bulky items of refuse (eg furniture, carpets and kitchen equipment).

Refuse disposal includes any treatment of waste collected by the council and destined for final disposal in landfill. It includes sorting, compacting, baling, shredding, composting, recycling and incineration. The operation of transfer-loading stations and the provision of civic amenity sites or skips should be regarded as disposal.

### *Points to bear in mind*

The cost of refuse collection will be affected by:

- the method of collection, since this influences the time taken to collect refuse from individual premises
- the frequency of uplift
- the volume of refuse to be collected
- the area over which the population is spread
- difficulties caused by traffic congestion and access problems in urban areas

Scotland's councils use the wheeled bin method of collection, which tends to reduce collection costs, particularly in areas where householders take the bins to the kerbside, thus reducing collection time for councils. The alternative methods are the uplift of static bins or sacks from either the back door of dwellings or from the kerbside.

The great majority of councils collect domestic refuse once a week, though a small number operate a twice-weekly uplift – mainly for tenement and high rise flats. Most councils undertake separate collections of other waste e.g. garden refuse, waste paper, etc. Generally, uplifts from commercial premises are carried out two or three times a week.

No charge is made for the normal domestic refuse collection service, although some councils now charge for special uplifts of bulky domestic refuse.

Some councils have access to existing landfill sites which although unable to meet the standards prescribed by European legislation, have sufficient remaining capacity to provide lower disposal costs. There is every possibility that in the future, when new, more expensive sites are required, costs will rise.

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## Refuse collection complaints

- 2: The number of complaints per 1,000 households regarding the household waste collection service**

### *What the indicator reports*

This indicator shows the recorded incidence of complaints to the council arising from its refuse collection service. These may be due to missed collections or other matters such as spillage of refuse or complaints about an operative's attitude.

### *Points to bear in mind*

Complaints may arise from a number of causes. However it is recognised that for a service such as refuse collection, they can be seen as a direct measure of the extent to which householders express dissatisfaction with the service they receive.

Reported performance may be affected by the quality on councils' customer contact mechanisms.

## Refuse Recycling

- 3: The amount of municipal waste collected by the authority during the year that was recycled or disposed of by the following methods:**

### *What the indicator reports*

The indicator shows the methods adopted by councils for managing municipal waste. The key legislation that councils need to consider in determining how their waste is managed is the European Union Landfill Directive (July 1999) which sets local authorities targets for reducing the amount of biodegradable municipal waste disposed at landfill. Under the proposals, biodegradable municipal waste landfilled must be reduced to 35% of the 1995 level by 2020.

The government has set councils the target of recycling 25% of household waste by the year 2006. A European Commission (EC) directive has set new targets for the amount of biodegradable waste that goes to landfill sites and the first of these targets is that by 2006 the amount of waste going to landfill must be reduced to three quarters of the 1995 level.

The indicator also shows each council's estimate of its achievement in recycling waste. Councils obtain waste material for recycling in three ways - through collections at recycling centres (eg bottle banks, paper banks), by separate house-to-house collection of recyclable materials, or by separating waste after collection.

Municipal waste includes waste from households and commercial premises, civic amenity sites, street and beach cleaning, parks/gardens and collection of fly tipped waste.

### *Points to bear in mind*

Councils need to find alternative methods of disposing of refuse, and recycling will become an even higher priority. The key factors under the control of a council for recycling are its expenditure on promotional campaigns and collection, and its investment in a recycling plant.

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The major external factors that have a significant impact upon recycling levels are:

- the level of public awareness of the value of recycling
- the willingness of the public to participate in recycling household waste
- fluctuations in market demand for recycled materials.

## Street cleanliness

**4: The cleanliness index achieved following inspection of a sample of streets and other relevant land.**

### *What the indicator reports*

The indicator shows the cleanliness index of a local authority's streets and other relevant land.

Cleanliness is a measure based on the amount of litter (eg smoking related, sweet wrappers, drinks related, fast food packaging and animal faeces).

Relevant streets and land are defined in the Code of Practice on Litter and Refuse 1999. Streets and land refers to those areas that the council is responsible for.

Keep Scotland Beautiful (KSB) has developed criteria against which cleanliness is to be measured. The process is known as the 'local environmental audit and management system' (LEAMS). ### *Points to bear in mind*

Various factors will affect the overall cleanliness within a council's area. These will include:

- council policy on litter picking to a greater extent rather than street sweeping
- the lack of litter bins, especially in town centres
- awareness and education of the public is a key priority and this will be done through actions and campaigns to alert the general public to the problems associated with cleanliness and in particular dog fouling
- the adoption and implementation of enforcement powers available to councils.

## Abandoned vehicles

**N WM 5: The number of abandoned vehicles that require to be removed by the council, and the percentage removed within 14 days.**

### *What the indicator reports*

This indicator reports the number of abandoned vehicles made known to the council that require to be removed and the percentage of these removed within 14 calendar days. Councils are permitted direct access to the DVLA which speeds up identification of abandoned vehicles.

The time to remove vehicles starts when the council becomes aware of an abandoned vehicle through inspections; notification received from a member of the public or the police, or any other source.

### *Points to bear in mind*

The removal of abandoned vehicles is dependent on the council working with its partners. The police have an important role to play and councils will want to ensure that procedures are in place which minimise delay in the removal of abandoned vehicles.
